

## The Village of Huntington Bay reminds residents to Recycle Right.

Every time a resident chooses to recycle, he or she is giving that item a second life to serve a new purpose and save natural resources. Now more than ever it's important to recycle.

Winters Bros. collects trash and recyclables within the Village. Winters Bros. is asking residents to be good recyclers and keep recyclables free from contamination. Please DO NOT place non-recyclable materials or garbage in the recycling bin.

To be a good recycler, please:

1. Recycle clean bottles, cans, paper, and cardboard.
2. Keep food and liquid out of your recycling container.
3. Do not place plastic bags in the recycling bin and do not bag recyclables.

The wrong materials in a recycling bin will adversely impact recycling. Currently, about 7 to 9 percent of what is delivered to the recycling center is contaminated material that people mistakenly placed into the recycle bin. Placing wrong material in your recycling bin substantially increases costs at the recycling center.

Glass recycling has come under increased pressure recently, and many municipal programs are no longer collecting curbside glass since it is often heavily contaminated. Winters Bros. encourages residents to take NY-refundable glass materials to the bottle return section of a local grocery store. If not, glass should be placed into the regular trash.

It would be very beneficial for all residents of Huntington Bay to "Recycle Right". We hope that this communication will get our community back on track as we recycle today for a better tomorrow.

***And remember, recycling day in Huntington Bay is Wednesday for ALL recycling material.***

**Paper, Newspaper, Magazines & Junk Mail**

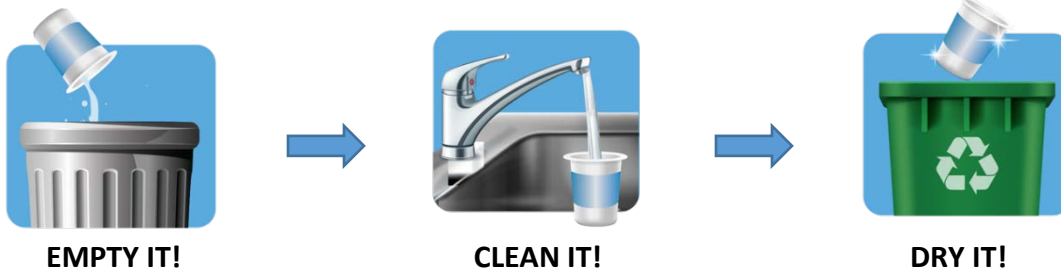
No Need to Tie or Bundle

## What NOT to place in curbside recycling containers:

- Glass (bottles, jars, windows, mirrors)
- Cat litter
- Chemicals
- Household hazardous waste
- Contaminated paper products
- Dry cleaning bags
- Food waste
- Garbage
- Light bulbs
- Needles/syringes/sharp items
- Paint and paint cans
- Plates (plastic and ceramic)
- Plastics labeled:  

- Plastic shopping bags
- Plastic utensils
- Styrofoam
- Waxed paper
- Yard waste
- Drinking glasses

Recyclables from the Village go to Winters Bros. recycling facility at 19 Nancy Street, West Babylon. At the plant, the recyclables are sorted and processed. Non-recyclable materials are separated. The sorted recyclables are sent to manufacturers for additional processing (grinding, pulping, etc.) before they are available as a feed stock to make new products.
