INCORPORATED VILLAGE OF HUNTINGTON BAY Local Law No. 1 of the Year 2014

PROPOSED LOCAL LAW NO. 1 OF 2014 AMENDING CHAPTER 20, ARTICLE II, OF THE CODE OF THE INCORPORATED VILLAGE OF HUNTINGTON BAY AS IT RELATES TO THE KEEPING OR HARBORING OF CERTAIN ANIMALS IN THE VILLAGE

Be it enacted by the Board of Trustees of the Incorporated Village of Huntington Bay as follows:

Section 1. Amendment.

Chapter 20, Article II, of the Code of the Village of Huntington Bay shall be amended to read as follows:

§ 20-7.1. Certain animals prohibited.

No person shall harbor, keep and maintain within the Village limits any livestock, poultry or fowl, including, but not limited to, pigs, swine, horses, donkeys, cows, cattle, goats, sheep, llamas, alpacas, chickens, roosters, ducks, geese, peacocks or pigeons, but the keeping of a reasonable number of customary household pets is not hereby prohibited.

Section 2. Severability.

If any clause, sentence, paragraph, section, or part of this local law shall be adjudged by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder hereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, section or part hereof directly involved in the controversy in which judgment should have been rendered.

Section 3. Effective date.

This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the New York Secretary of State.
